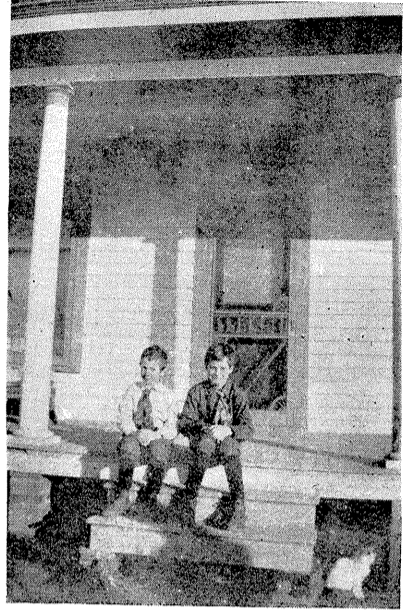

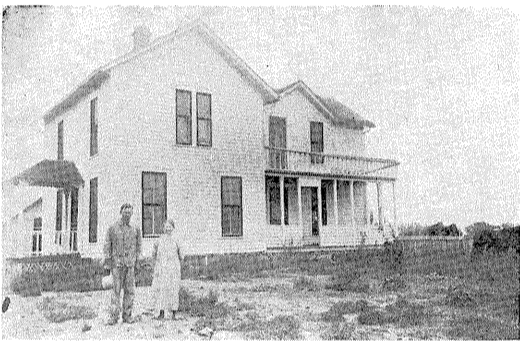

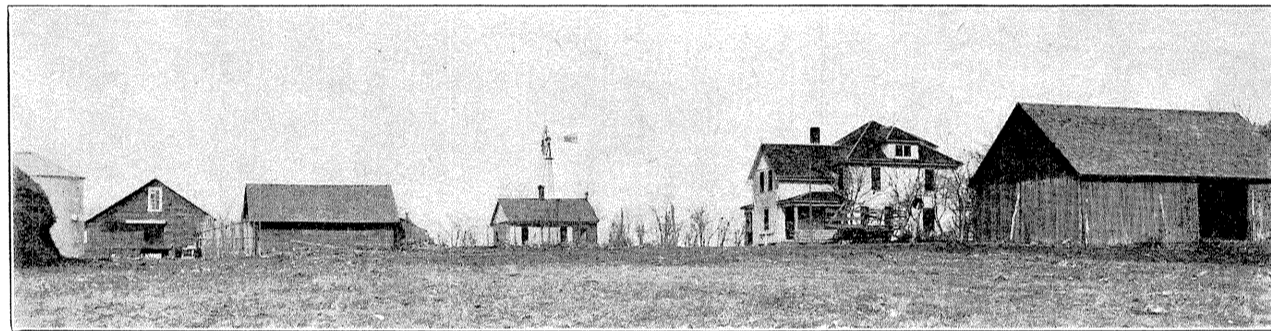

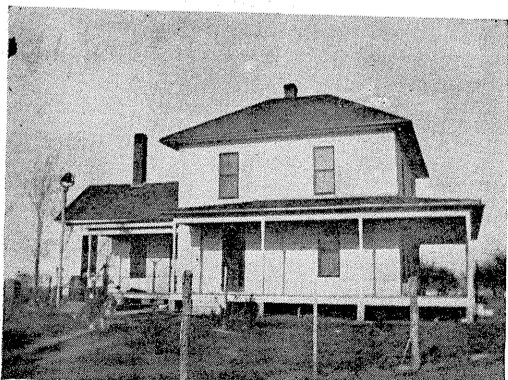


IMMENSE OAK TREE ON FARM

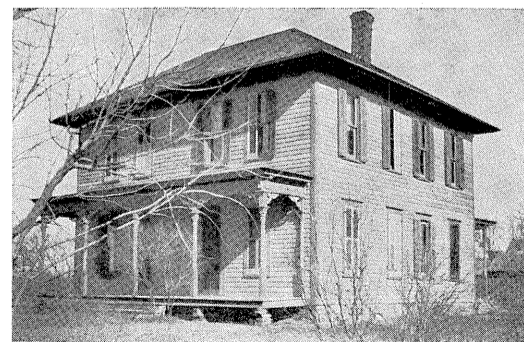

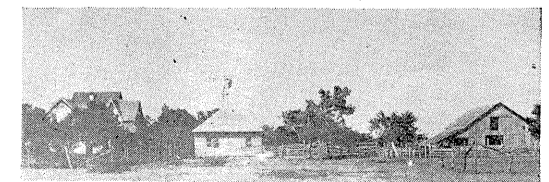
